TRACINGS - MIKE TRACY

Balalo / Tracing / Once I Loved.

Basically this is a very fine quartet of Michael Tracytenor, soprano and percussion, Renato Vasconcelloskeyboards and percussion, Tyrone Wheeler - acoustic and electric bass, Terry O'Mahoney - drums and percussion, but Steve Allee's stylish piano is added to tracks 1 and 7.

great Brazilian drummer Erivelton Silva is added to the exciting rhythm section on tracks 5, 6 and 8. The rhythmic guitar of Pat Lentz is on tracks 2 and 3 whilst the haunting "Vera Cruz" has a wordless vocal by Kathy

Jordan add the rich toned tenor of Mike Tracy and you have a very exciting group. The interplay between soloists and ensemble work is quite breathtaking. A very fine

example of Brazilian Jazz in a modern manner with a wonderful display of percussive instruments. Sample "August 5" which is between a Cuban mambo feel and Mike Tracy's driving tenor in a swing manner.

Incidentally the CD includes some really lovely bass playing from Tyrone Wheeler. (PETER GREEN)
